## **Florence Falls 4WD Campground Re-Open**

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment and The Arts advises that the Florence Falls 4WD Campground at Litchfield National Park is re-open for the season.

Other attractions such as Surprise Creek Falls, Sandy Creek Falls, Reynolds River, Walker Creek, Bamboo Creek and the Lost City remain closed until the 4WD tracks dry out, and maintenance from wet season damage is undertaken to prepare for the dry season.

Florence Falls and Buley Rock Hole swimming areas are open for public use.

Wangi Falls swimming area remains closed however people can still visit and enjoy viewing the falls and use the kiosk and picnic facilities available there.

Access to Litchfield National Park is still via Batchelor only and visitors are reminded to drive with due caution as water may still be over roads at causeways.
