Kings Creek Walk Under Repairs

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment and The Arts wishes to advise that the Kings Creek walk at Watarrka National Park will be undergoing repairs and maintenance between 4 June and 25 July 2008.

Parks and Wildlife Service Senior District Ranger Chris Howard said that the repairs and maintenance works included building rock steps and re-paving the track surface along the path.

“It is anticipated that the works will provide a safer, more comfortable walk for visitors and also assist in the protection of Watarrka’s natural resources,” Mr Howard said.

“Some disruptions to normal traffic flow may be experienced as some sections of the track are narrower than usual, temporary diversions will be in place and visitors will be directed around works as required.”

The Canyon Rim Walk, the Giles Track and the Kathleen Springs walks will all be open for visitors to access during this period.
