## **Litchfield National Park Closures**

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport advises that due to recent wet weather conditions Surprise Creek Falls and Bamboo Creek at Litchfield National Park are now closed for the duration of the wet season.

The Florence Falls 4WD campground and Wangi Falls campground are also closed for the season, however the Florence Falls 2WD campground and Buley Rock Hole campgrounds remain open.

Other attractions such as Walker Creek, Tolmer Falls and the Lost City remain open.

Swimming areas at Wangi Falls, Florence Falls and Buley Rock Hole are also open for public use.

The Reynolds 4WD Track and Table Top Walking Track are closed and Sandy Creek Falls is open via Litchfield Park Road only.
