Buley Rockhole and Florence Falls Closed for Swimming

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport (NRETAS) advise that due to wet weather conditions Buley Rockhole and Florence Falls in Litchfield National Park are temporarily closed for swimming.

Heavy rainfall has resulted in high water levels and increased turbidity of the water with swimming closed to ensure visitor safety. These sites will reopen when wet weather conditions subside.

Access to Litchfield National Park via Cox Peninsula Road is also closed for the remainder of the wet season.
