Territory Wildlife Park and Botanic Gardens Closures

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport (NRETAS) wish to advise that the Territory Wildlife Park and George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens are both temporarily closed to all visitors until further notice due to the wet weather conditions.

Heavy rains and strong winds have caused damage to foliage and loosened debris within the Botanic Gardens, resulting in a temporary closure until such time that staff can determine that it is safe for visitors.

Areas of Territory Wildlife Park are experiencing localised flooding and have also been deemed unsafe for visitors.

It is anticipated that the Botanic Gardens and Territory Wildlife Park will reopen when wet weather conditions subside.
