## **Update of Closures Due to Weather Conditions**

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport (NRETAS) advises that the following facilities have **reopened** to the public:

### **Parks & Reserves**

- Charles Darwin National Park
- Leanyer Recreation Park

### **Arts & Culture**

- Archives NT
- Arts NT
- NT Herbarium
- The Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory (MAGNT)
- The Northern Territory Library

The following **temporary closures** still apply due to the current weather conditions:

- Berry Springs Nature Park
- Casuarina Coastal Reserve (except Dripstone Cliffs and beach)
- Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve
- Holmes Jungle Nature Park
- Howard Springs Nature Park
- Djukbinj National Park
- Leaning Tree Lagoon Nature Park
- Litchfield National Park
- Manton Dam Recreation Area
- Mary River National Park
- Territory Wildlife Park
- Umbrawarra Gorge Nature Park
- Douglas Hot Springs
- Windows on the Wetlands Visitor Centre
- George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens

Butterfly Gorge Nature Park, Channel Point, Tjuwaliyn (Douglas) Hot Springs Park and most areas of Litchfield National Park and Mary River National Park are seasonally closed for the duration of the wet season and these closures remain in place.
