Parks Closures Update

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport (NRETAS) advises that Litchfield National Park has re-opened to the public however all sites remain closed to swimming until water levels reduce to a safe level.

All areas of Casuarina Coastal Reserve have re-opened to the public.

The following **temporary closures** still apply due to the current weather conditions:

- Berry Springs Nature Park
- Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve
- Holmes Jungle Nature Park
- Djukbinj National Park
- Leaning Tree Lagoon Nature Park
- Litchfield National Park (all sites closed to swimming)
- Manton Dam Recreation Area
- Mary River National Park
- Umbrawarra Gorge Nature Park
- Windows on the Wetlands Visitor Centre
- George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens

Butterfly Gorge Nature Park, Channel Point, Tjuwaliyn (Douglas) Hot Springs Park and most areas of Litchfield National Park and Mary River National Park are seasonally closed for the duration of the wet season and these closures remain in place.

NRETAS will advise when these areas will re-open to the public.
