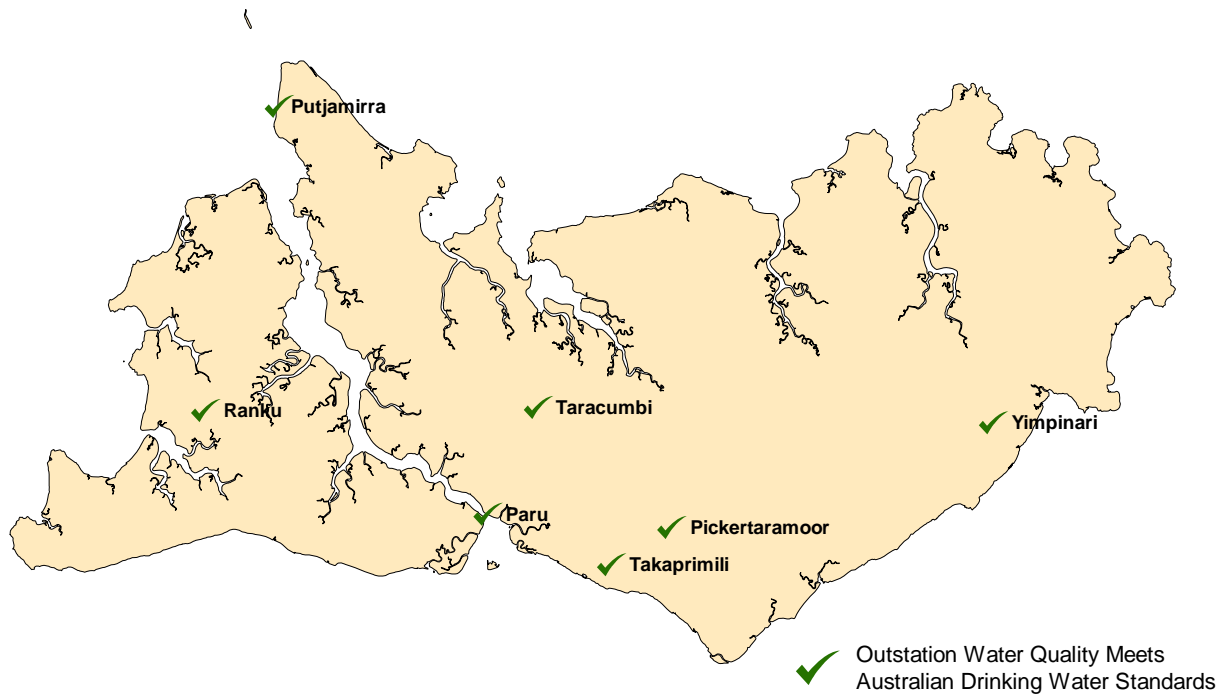




Tiwi Islands Outstation Water Quality Results

As part of developing a Water Resource Strategy for the Tiwi Islands, the Department of Natural Resources, Environment The Arts And Sport – Water Resources Branch have been working closely with the Tiwi Land Rangers to collect information about water quality at Tiwi Island's outstations.

Water Quality samples were collected and analysed in 2009 as a part of 'Phase 1 Assessment of Water Quality in Northern Territory Outstations and Homelands' project, run by the Department of Housing, Local Government and Regional Services (DHLGRS).



The *Australian Drinking Water Guidelines* help to make sure drinking water is of a good quality and safe to drink. Water samples have been collected across the Islands and assessed by Power and Water Corporation on behalf of DHLGRS; it was found that in 2009 water quality at all outstations on the Tiwi Islands meet *Australian Drinking Water Guidelines*.
