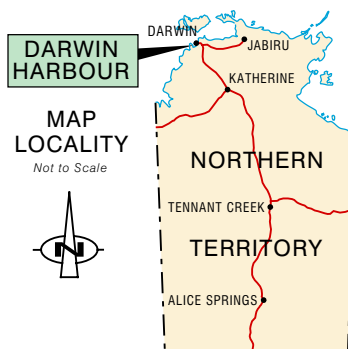
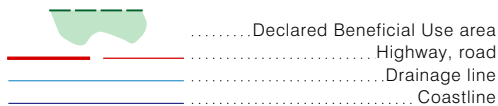

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DECLARED BENEFICIAL USES:

The protection of aquatic ecosystems and recreational water quality and aesthetics to be beneficial uses that apply to the area of water known as Darwin Harbour, being all saline waters south of a line drawn from Charles Point to Lee Point and bounded by the upper limit of the high water mark of tidal waters, including all named and unnamed inlets and creeks.
