DECLARATION OF BENEFICIAL USES AND OBJECTIVES OF WATER COPPERFIELD CREEK

I, KEITH JOHN AUSTIN ASCHE, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of section 73(1) of the *Water Act*, declare -

- (a) raw water for drinking water supply to be a beneficial use which applies to the water in -
 - (i) the waterway known as Copperfield Creek; and
 - (ii) all its tributaries that enter the creek.

upstream of a point situated at latitude 13 degrees 51 minutes 46 seconds South longitude 131 degrees 49 minutes 6 seconds East;

- (b) aquatic ecosystem protection to be a beneficial use which applies to the water in -
 - (i) the waterway known as Copperfield Creek; and
 - (ii) all its tributaries that enter the creek.

downstream of a point situated at latitude 13 degrees 51 minutes 46 seconds South longitude 131 degrees 49 minutes 6 seconds East; and

- (c) the objectives which apply to the water in the area specified in -
 - (i) paragraph (a) to be as specified in table 4.1; and
 - (ii) paragraph (b) to be as specified in table 2.1.

REVOCATION OF DECLARATION AND DECLARATION OF BENEFICIAL USES AND OBJECTIVES OF WATER COPPERFIELD CREEK

I, NEIL RAYMOND CONN, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council -

- (a) in pursuance of section 73(1) of the *Water Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument of declaration of beneficial uses and objectives of water dated 15 December 1995 and published in *Gazette* No. S43 dated 19 December 1995 at pages 2 and 3; and

- (b) in pursuance of section 73(1) of the *Water Act*, declare-
 - (i) raw water for drinking water supply is the beneficial use which applies to the water in -
 - (A) the waterway known as Copperfield Creek; and
 - (B) all its tributaries that enter the waterway,

upstream of Zone 52 Australian Map Grid point 804650E 8465660N (source 1:50,000 Topographic Map Series R722, Sheet 5270 - II, Edition 1 - AAS);

- (ii) aquatic ecosystem protection is the beneficial use which applies to the water in -

- (A) the waterway known as Copperfield Creek; and
- (B) all its tributaries that enter the waterway,

downstream of Zone 52 Australian Map Grid point 804650E 8465660N (source 1:50,000 Topographic Map Series R722, Sheet 5270 - II, Edition 1 - AAS); and

- (iii) the objectives which apply to water in the area specified in -

- (A) subparagraph (i) are as specified in table 4.1; and

- (B) subparagraph (ii) are as specified in table 2.1.
