DECLARATION OF BENEFICIAL USE
CRATER LAKE

I, NEIL RAYMOND CONN, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of section 73(1) of the *Water Act*, declare that, in relation to the body of water known as Crater Lake situated in section 2885, Hundred of Goyder at the intersection of the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid Line 726650E and the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid line 8556750N (source 1:50,000 Topographic Map Series R722, Sheet 5171-4, Edition 2-AAS), the beneficial use is recreational water quality and aesthetics as specified in Table 3.2 in the document entitled "Australian Water Quality Guidelines for Fresh and Marine Waters" published by the Australian and New Zealand Environment and Conservation Council and dated November 1992.
