SCHEDULE

All those marine waters in the Northern Territory of Australia bounded by the upper limit of the high water mark of tidal waters, including all named and unnamed rivers and creeks, and generally described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid line 672577mE and the upper limit of the high water mark of the coast; thence generally southerly easterly along the shoreline to the Giddy River; thence generally easterly along the shoreline to the Latram River; thence

generally north westerly along the shoreline to Wargarpunda Point; thence generally easterly along the shoreline to the intersection of the Zone 53 Australian Map Grid line 8655057mN and the upper limit of the high water mark at Cape Wirawawoi; thence north westerly in a straight line to the point of commencement.
