**REVOCATION OF DECLARATION AND  
DECLARATION OF WATER QUALITY OBJECTIVE  
HOWLEY CREEK**

I, NEIL RAYMOND CONN, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council -

- (a) in pursuance of section 73(1) of the *Water Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument of declaration of water quality objective dated 29 February 1996 and published in *Gazette No. G11* dated 13 March 1996 at page 3; and
- (b) in pursuance of section 73(1) of the *Water Act*, declare that, in relation to the area of water specified in the Schedule, the objective is to sustain its aquatic ecosystem as specified in table 2.1 in the document entitled "Australian Water Quality Guidelines for Fresh and Marine Waters" published by the Australian and New Zealand Environment and Conservation Council and dated November 1992.
