SCHEDULE

All those marine waters in the Northern Territory of Australia bounded by the upper limit of the high water mark of tidal waters, including all named and unnamed rivers and creeks, and generally described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid line 706050mE and the upper limit of the high water mark at Lee Point; thence generally easterly along the shoreline to Hope Inlet; thence generally northerly along the shoreline to Gunn Point; thence generally easterly along the shoreline to the intersection of the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid line 734650mE and the upper limit of the high water mark at Point Stephens; thence north along the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid line 734650mE; thence west along the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid line 8670000mN; thence south along the Zone 52 Australian Map Grid line 706050mE to the point of commencement.
