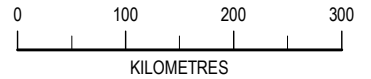
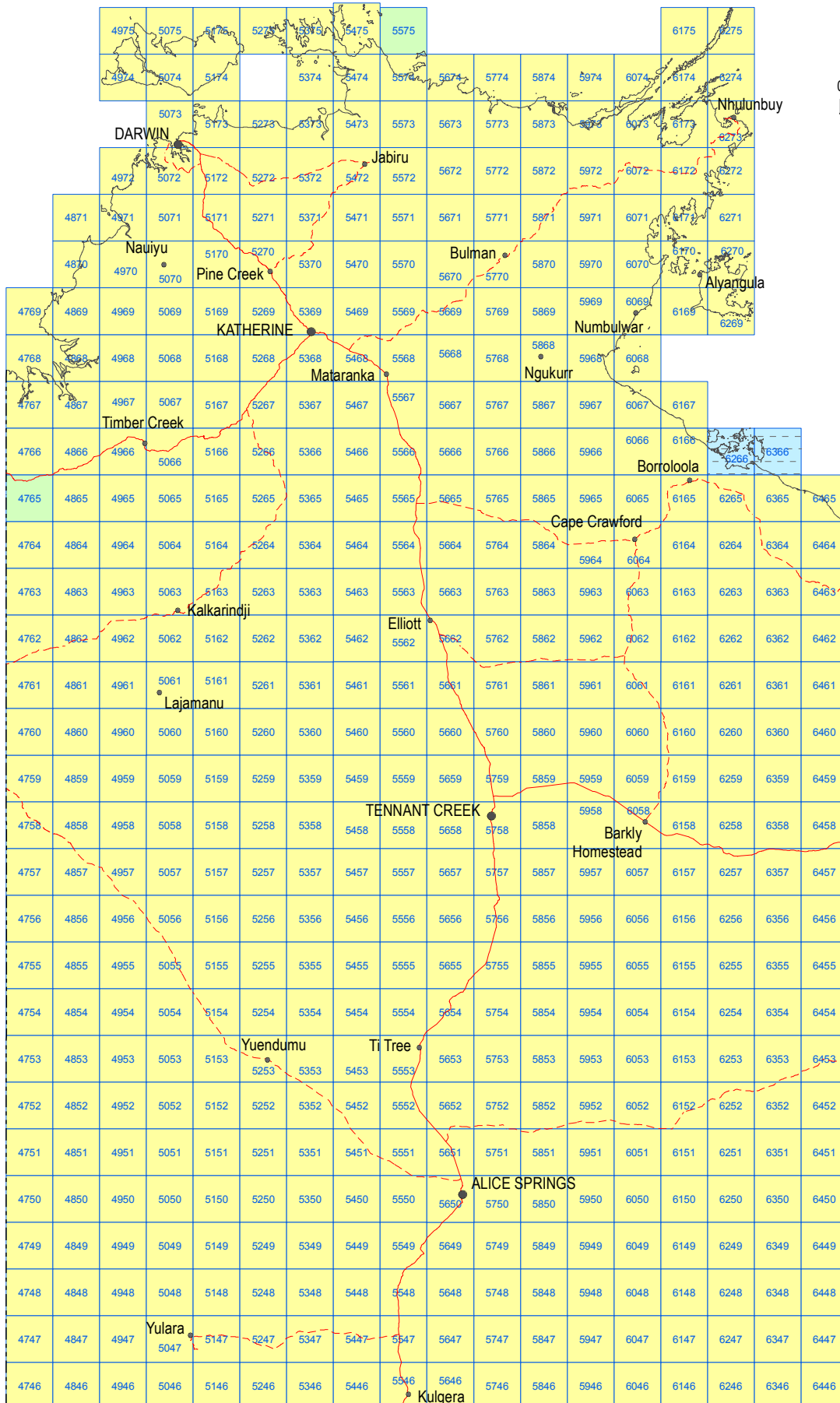




# Feral goat
