OFFER OF CROWN LAND FOR SALE BY AUCTION

I, Nichola June D'Antoine, the Delegate of the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 13(1) of the *Crown Lands Act*, give notice that:

- (a) a public auction shall be conducted on **1 March 2008 at 11.00 o'clock in the morning, at the Douglas Daly Community Hall on Lot 16, Town of Fleming, NT;**
- (b) Crown term leases over the parcels of land described in Schedule 1 shall be offered at the auction;
- (c) Column 5 of Schedule 1 defines the purpose for which the land may be used, subject to any other law in force in the Territory;
- (d) the leases of the parcels of land which are identified in Schedule 1 shall be for a term as specified in column 7 and shall be subject to the general provisions of the *Crown Lands Act* and to the conditions set out in Schedule 2;
- (e) the annual rental payable in respect of each parcel of land described in Schedule 1 shall be \$5000 (plus GST);
- (f) there are no improvements on the parcels of land described in Schedule 1;
- (g) the successful bids for the Crown term leases to be offered at the auction shall not be less than the reserve price set in respect of each of the Crown term leases. Should the bidding in relation to each separate lot not reach the reserve price, the highest bidder shall be given the right to purchase the Crown lease term at the reserve price or at such other price as either the Minister for Planning and Lands or any delegate appointed by her for this purpose under section 7 of the *Crown Lands Act* shall accept. Should the highest bidder not exercise that right immediately in relation to one of the Crown term leases offered or should the highest offer made immediately after the unsuccessful sale of a Crown term lease offered at auction not be accepted, that Crown lease term shall from that time be available for sale over the counter at the reserve price, or at such other price as the Minister may determine, subject to the advertised conditions and on a first come, first served basis until withdrawn from sale;
- (h) where any lot is sold but where the terms of the contract of sale are not completed, the lot will immediately become available for sale over the counter at the reserve price or at such other price as the Minister may determine, on a first come first served basis;
- (i) the successful purchaser of a parcel of land described in Schedule 1 shall be required to enter into a contract of sale for the purchase of the Crown term lease and shall, at the time of purchase, pay to the Territory a deposit of not less than 10% of the purchase price. Payment of the balance of the purchase price shall be by cash or bank cheque;
- (j) the contract of sale in respect of the Crown term leases of any of the parcels of land described in Schedule 1 shall contain a clause that the completion of the contract of sale shall take place within 30 days after the date of the execution of the contract of sale. Where the successful purchaser does not complete the purchase as required by the contract of sale, including the time specified for the completion of the sale, the deposit, except that amount that exceeds 10% of the purchase price, shall be forfeited to the Territory;
- (k) the contracts of sale in respect of the Crown term leases of the parcels of land described in Schedule 1 shall each

contain a clause that the purchaser agrees that the deposit paid is to be accepted by the agent (auctioneer) on behalf of the Territory and once paid to the agent (auctioneer) is to be paid to the Receiver of Territory Monies, Department of Planning and Infrastructure, as soon as practicable but no later than settlement;

- (l) a clause of the contract of sale in respect of each of the Crown term leases shall require the successful purchaser to satisfy himself as to the boundaries of the parcel of land the subject of a Crown lease term of a parcel of land described in Schedule 1;
- (m) Crown term leases of each of the parcels of land shall be granted subject to its present state regarding road access and each purchaser will be responsible for access (crossover) from Rixon Street (gravel standard) to the leased land;
- (n) Crown term leases of each of the parcels of land shall be granted with a provision that a water supply is available from a tank situated within Lot 9, Town of Fleming and the successful purchaser shall agree to pay a fee for the amount of water used to the Douglas Daly Community

Development Association Inc. to cover maintenance and operating costs to the infrastructure during the term of the lease or until such a time that the purchaser has installed a water supply suitable for the development on the leased land and does not require any water from the tank situated within Lot 9, Town of Fleming;

- (o) Crown term leases of each of the parcels of land shall be granted with the provision that there is no trunk sewerage, drainage or electricity supply connection to or on the land;
- (p) when the purchase price has been paid in full, a Crown lease term of the selected parcel of land shall be granted and shall be subject to the *Crown Lands Act* and to any other law in force in the Territory; and

SCHEDULE 2

LOTS 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 AND 8, TOWN OF FLEMING

The Leases of Lots 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 8, Town of Fleming (described in Schedule 1) shall contain the following conditions:

- 1. Subject to the *Crown Lands Act*, the Lessee will not use the leased land for a purpose other than the purpose for which it is leased, **Viz: Light Industry/Service Commercial**

– to provide for light industry uses or development activities that will not by the nature of their operations, detrimentally affect adjoining or nearby land and to provide for commercial activities which because of the nature of their business or size of the population catchments, require large sites.

- 2. The annual rental fixed under the lease will commence nine (9) months from the date of commencement of the

- lease with no remissions for the remaining term of the lease subject to Conditions 3 and 4 hereunder.
3. Where development is commenced within nine (9) months from the date of commencement of the lease but is not completed within thirty (30) months from the date of commencement of the lease, then the rental under this lease shall apply from the specified completion date subject to condition 4 hereunder.
 4. The rental determined under this lease is not payable if development in terms of the lease is commenced within nine (9) months from the date of commencement of the lease, and is completed within thirty (30) months of the commencement date of the lease.
 5. The Lessee will within nine (9) months from the date of commencement of each of the leases or within such further time as may be approved in writing by the Minister for that purpose, commence to erect improvements in accordance with the lease purpose on the leased land to a value of not less than the sum of **one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)** and the Lessee shall complete the erection of the said improvements to a value of not less than the said sum within thirty (30) months from the date of commencement of the lease or within such further time as may be approved in writing by the Minister.
 6. The Lessee acknowledges that a caretaker's residence ancillary to the use as Light Industry/Service Commercial purposes is permitted. The construction of any such caretaker's residence will not be construed as forming part of the costs of development to a value of **one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)** outlined in condition 5 of the lease.
 7. The Lessee acknowledges that water will be available from a water tank sourced within Lot 9, Town of Fleming and agrees to pay a fee for the amount of water used to the Douglas Daly Community Development Association Inc. to cover maintenance and pumping costs for the infrastructure associated with the water supply from Lot 16, Town of Fleming to the tank situated on Lot 9, Town of Fleming.
 8. The Lessee acknowledges that the water supply on Lot 9, Town of Fleming is of a temporary nature and the lessee will be required to install a water supply suitable for the development on the leased land at the Lessee's cost.
 9. The Lessee will be responsible for the provision of access (crossover) from Rixon Street (gravel surface), power, drainage and the installation of a septic system at the Lessee's cost to the satisfaction of the relevant authority.
 10. The Lessee will pay rates and taxes which may at any time become due in respect of the leased land.
 11. The Lessee will at all times be responsible for the removal of waste from the leased land to an approved waste disposal facility.
 12. All development shall be in accordance with any Control Plan or Development Permit under the *Planning Act* affecting the leased land.
 13. The Lessee will ensure that all building plans have the necessary approvals prior to commencement of building.
 14. The Lessee will, in respect of the land included in the lease, ensure that at all times and to the satisfaction of the Minister, the land is kept clean, tidy and free

of noxious weeds and other designated weeds, debris, dry herbage, rubbish, carcasses of animals and other unsightly or offensive, poisonous, toxic or hazardous matter and harbour for insects, pests and the breeding of mosquitoes.

15. If the Lessee fails to observe and carry out or to cause to be observed or carried out the requirements of Condition 14 above on its part, the Territory shall have a right to enter onto the demised premises and do all things necessary to that end and the expense and cost thereof, as determined by the Minister, shall be borne and payable by the Lessee on demand.
16. The Lessee may on completion of development in terms of the lease and upon payment of any monies owing to the Territory surrender the lease in exchange for a freehold title at nil cost, subject to payment of any administrative costs and lodgement fees.

RULES AND INFORMATION FOR THE GUIDANCE OF INTENDING BIDDERS

Prospective purchasers are advised that a private licensed auctioneer, **Mr Tony Pickering of KG Young and Associates** has been appointed to conduct this public auction on behalf of the Territory.

Each successful purchaser shall be required to provide their full name, residential address (including street or lot number) and occupation. This information is required so that the contract of sale for a Crown lease term can be correctly completed.

Any person intending to bid on behalf of any company, business organisation or another person must produce satisfactory evidence of their authority to bid on behalf of their principal, otherwise the Crown lease term shall go to the successful bidder and the contract of sale shall be executed in their name only. In the case of companies, such evidence must be under company seal and accompanied with a Certificate of Registration showing the correct title and registered address of the company. Such evidence must be produced to the auctioneer before the auction date in order to avoid delay at the sale.

Persons bidding on behalf of a company are advised that the Articles of Association of the Company may be required to be produced at Land Administration, Second Floor, Cavenagh House, 38 Cavenagh Street, Darwin before a Crown lease term can be issued.
