



### Weeds Management Act

#### DECLARED WEED

I, Alison Anderson, Minister for Natural Resources, Environment and Heritage, under section 7(1) of the *Weeds Management Act*, declare gamba grass (*Andropogon gayanus*) to be a declared weed (the declared weed) and:

- (a) having regard to section 7(4)(a) of the *Act*, classify the declared weed as a Class A weed for the purposes of preventing the plant entering into, or managing the plant in, the part of the Territory described in Schedule 1 and indicated on the map in Schedule 3; and
- (b) having regard to section 7(4)(b) of the *Act*, classify the declared weed as a Class B weed for the purposes of preventing the plant entering into, or managing the plant in, the part of the Territory described in Schedule 2 and indicated on the map in Schedule 3; and
- (c) having regard to section 7(4)(c) of the *Act*, classify the declared weed as a Class C weed for the purpose of preventing the plant entering into the Territory.

#### SCHEDULE 1 CLASS A AREA

All of the Territory except the area described in Schedule 2.

#### SCHEDULE 2 CLASS B AREA

Inside that area starting at the Daly River mouth, then generally north-east along the coast to the western boundary of Kakadu National Park, then south along the western boundary of Kakadu National Park to the northern boundary

of Nitmiluk National Park, then east along the northern boundary of Nitmiluk National Park, then generally south along the eastern boundary of Nitmiluk National Park, then generally west along the southern boundary of Nitmiluk National Park, to the eastern boundary of NTP 6337, then south along the eastern boundary of NTP 6337 to the northern boundary of NTP 4192, then generally in a east-north-east direction along the northern-eastern boundary of NTP 4192 to the southern boundary of Nitmiluk National Park to the Katherine River, then generally west-south-west along the Katherine River, then north along the Daly River to the northern boundary of NTP 4059, then west along the northern boundary of NTP 4059, then south along the western boundary of NTP 4059, then west along the northern boundary of NTP 4059 and 1637, then north along the western boundary of NTP 2700 and 1666 then generally north-west along the Daly River to the Daly River mouth, which is shown on the map as the area banded by the thick black line.
