FEES AND LEVIES

I, KONSTANTINE VATSKALIS, Minister for Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources:

- (a) under regulations 206 and 207 of the Fisheries Regulations and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the notice prescribing fees and levies under the Fisheries Regulations dated 22 April 2008 and published in *Gazette* G18 of 7 May 2008; and
- (b) under regulation 206(1)(a) of the Fisheries Regulations, prescribe, for a licence of the type specified in the Schedule, column 1 (other than a licence granted in accordance with regulations 76A(1), 98(1), 102(2), 141D(2), 141F(1), 141L(2) or 141S(2)), the fee payable to be the amount specified opposite in column 2; and

- (g) under regulation 206(1)(d), prescribe the fee payable for the replacement of a licence, permit or certificate of registration of a vessel to be \$25; and
- (h) under regulation 207(1), prescribe the levy to be paid by an applicant for the grant or renewal of a licence listed in Schedule 3 of the Regulations (other than a licence granted in accordance with regulation 76A(1), 98(1), 102(2), 141D(2), 141F(1), 141L(2) or 141S(2), or specified in regulation 207(2)), to be \$715; and
- (i) specify the fees prescribed in paragraphs (b) to (h) apply on and from the date this notice is published in the *Gazette*.
