Crown Lands Act**OFFER OF CROWN LAND FOR SALE BY AUCTION**

I, RICHARD JOHN MORRIS, the Delegate of the Minister for Lands and Planning, in pursuance of section 13(1) of the *Crown Lands Act*, give notice that:

- (a) a public auction shall be conducted on **31 January 2009 at 10:30am, at the Knotts Crossing Resort, Cameron Street, Katherine NT**;
- (b) a Crown lease term over the parcels of land described in Schedule 1 shall be offered at the auction;
- (c) the lease of the parcel of land which is identified in Schedule 1 shall be for a term as specified in column 7 and shall be subject to the general provisions of the *Crown Lands Act* and to the conditions set out in Schedule 2;
- (d) the annual rental payable in respect of the parcel of land described in Schedule 1 shall be 5% of the purchase price (plus GST);
- (e) there are no improvements on the parcel of land described in Schedule 1;

- (g) the successful purchaser of the parcel of land described in Schedule 1 shall be required to enter into a contract of sale for the purchase of the Crown lease term and shall, at the time of purchase, pay to the Territory a deposit of not less than 10% of the purchase price. Payment of the balance of the purchase price shall be by cash or bank cheque;
- (h) the contract of sale in respect of the Crown lease term of the parcel of land described in Schedule 1 shall contain a clause that the completion of the contract of sale shall take place within 60 days after the date of the execution of the contract of sale. Where the successful purchaser does not complete the purchase as required by the contract of sale, including the time specified for the completion of the sale, the deposit, except that amount that exceeds 10% of the purchase price, shall be forfeited to the Territory;
- (i) the contract of sale in respect of the Crown lease term of the parcel of land described in Schedule 1 shall contain a clause that the purchaser agrees that the deposit paid is to be accepted by the agent (auctioneer) on behalf of the Territory and once paid to the agent (auctioneer) is to be paid to the Receiver of Territory Monies, Department of

- Planning and Infrastructure, as soon as practicable but no later than settlement;
- (j) a clause of the contract of sale in respect of the Crown lease term shall require the successful purchaser to satisfy himself as to the boundaries of the parcel of land the subject of the Crown lease term of the parcel of land described in Schedule 1;
- (k) easements for the purpose of supplying services under the *Water Supply and Sewerage Act* and *Power and Water Authority Act* may be reserved out of the Crown lease term;

SCHEDULE 2

LOTS 3231 and 3232 TOWN OF KATHERINE

The Lease of **Lots 3231 and 3232, Town of Katherine NT** (described in Schedule 1) shall contain the following conditions:

1. Subject to the *Crown Lands Act* the Lessee will not use the leased land for a purpose other than the purpose for which it is leased, viz residential subdivision of not less than thirty five Lots.
2. The Lessee shall comply with the Development Agreement.
3. The annual rental fixed under this lease shall commence within six (6) months from the commencement of the lease with no remissions for the remainder of the lease subject to conditions 4 and 5 hereunder.
4. The rental determined under this lease is not payable if development is commenced within six (6) months of the commencement of the lease. For the purposes of this condition, commencement means the lodgement with the Development Consent Authority of an application for the subdivision and development of the lease area in accordance with the Development Agreement.
5. The rental determined under this lease is not payable if physical development is commenced within twelve (12) months of the commencement of the lease. For the purposes of this condition, physical commencement means the construction of road works, installation of storm water drainage, etc.
6. The Lessee will liaise with the Aboriginal Areas Protection Authority and adhere to the *Northern Territory Sacred Sites Act 1989* to the satisfaction of the Authority.
7. The Lessee shall not surrender or attempt to surrender the whole of the lease with view to obtaining freehold title until the Department of Planning and Infrastructure is satisfied all development works have been completed in full accordance with the Development Agreement.
8. The lessee shall concurrently lodge an application to amend the NT Planning Scheme as it relates to the land, for consideration by the Minister for Planning and Lands, and a subdivision application to create no less than thirty five lots for consideration by the Development Consent Authority.

9. The Lessee shall in carrying out the development works comply with the terms or conditions imposed or implied in respect of the development by the relevant consent authority under the *Northern Territory Planning Act*.
10. The Lessee will within twelve (12) months from the date of commencement of the lease or within such further time as may be approved in writing by the Minister for that purpose, commence to undertake works in accordance with the lease purpose, for a residential subdivision on the leased land in accordance with the approved subdivision instrument and complete the subdivision within two (2) years of the date of commencement of the lease or within such time as may be approved in writing by the Minister.
11. The Lessee shall within nine (9) months of the commencement of the lease submit to the Department of Planning and Infrastructure, a list of encumbrances and/or covenants consistent with the Development Agreement.
12. The Lessee will at all times comply with any Control Plan and /or Development Permit/s affecting the leased land.
13. The Lessee will ensure that development works are carried out in a way which does not create any unacceptable noise, nuisance, dust or hazard to any person working on or visiting the leased land, or to members of the public passing by or living in the area. In particular the Lessee will carry out such watering as, in the opinion of the Department of Planning and Infrastructure, is necessary for dust suppression.
14. The Lessee will pay rates and taxes which may at any time become due in respect of the leased land.
15. The Lessee will design and construct, at the Lessee's expense, all services to, and within, the leased land to the satisfaction of the relevant service authorities.
16. All electrical reticulation and services will be underground services only.
17. The Lessee will construct all internal roads, stormwater drainage, street lighting, footpaths and street-scaping to the satisfaction of the Katherine Town Council and in accordance with the Development Agreement.
18. The Lessee will provide at nil cost, all easements required over the leased land by the Northern Territory or its agents.

19. The Lessee covenants with the Minister that failure by the Lessee to complete development in accordance with the lease, subject to section 34 of the *Crown Lands Act*, will result in the forfeiture of that area of the leased land for which individual freehold title has not been granted, to the Crown.
20. The Lessee agrees to comply with the Department of Business and Employment's "Building NT Industry Framework" so as to ensure:
- (a) full, fair and enhanced opportunity for local industry, business and labour to participate in all phases from design through to operation;
 - (b) the highest possible level of procurement of goods, labour, materials and services from local manufacturers and businesses where these are competitive as to price, performance, quality, suitability and delivery requirements;
 - (c) formulation of specifications, tenders and other project documentation in such a way as to afford local industry, business and labour, an equal opportunity of participating in the supply of goods and services;
 - (d) consideration of Australian companies and use of Australian made products when orders are to be placed with industry and business located other than in the Northern Territory;
 - (e) provision of reports at a frequency stipulated by the Minister, which will keep the Northern Territory Government informed on the level of Northern Territory and Australian industry, business and labour participation, including, as necessary, why goods and or services have been sourced elsewhere;
- (f) utilisation by the Lessee of goods and/or services provided by the Territory Business Centre, Department of Business and Employment, in the identification of suitable capable Northern Territory and Australian suppliers; and ;
- (g) incorporation of these requirements (a-f) into all contracts entered into by the Lessee, with any third party to supply goods/and or services.
21. The Lessee will in respect of the land included in the lease, ensure that at all times and to the satisfaction of the Minister, the land is kept clean, tidy and free of weeds, debris, dry herbage, rubbish, carcasses of animals and other unsightly or offensive matter and harbour for insects, pests or the breeding of mosquitoes.
22. If the Lessee fails to observe and carry out or cause to be observed or carried out the requirements of condition 21 on their part, the Territory shall have the right to enter onto the demised premises and do all things necessary to that end and the expense and cost thereof, as determined by the Minister, shall be borne and payable by the Lessee on demand.
23. The Lessee will within nine (9) months of the commencement of the lease submit to the Department of Planning and Infrastructure, a list of encumbrances and/or covenants consistent with the Development Agreement, for lodgement on all titles to all lots produced as a result of the subdivision created by this lease. Titles will not be issued prior to the lodgement of the encumbrances and/or covenants required by this condition.
24. The Lessee will upon completion of the development in terms of the lease surrender the whole of the lease in exchange for estates in fee simple in accordance with the approved subdivision plan subject to statutory fees and charges.
