PROHIBITION OF ENTRY INTO A SAFETY ZONE

This safety zone extends to a distance of: five hundred meters, measured from:

Location (GDA94, zone 51) Latitude 12° 23' 06.19" South
Longitude 124° 16' 26.37" East

The Safety Zone remains in force for a period from the 13 May 2009 until 30 June 2009.

Where an unauthorised vessel enters or remains in the safety zone specified in contravention of this instrument, the owner and the person in command or in charge of the vessel are each guilty of an offence against section 616 of the *Act* and are punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$100,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years, or both, pursuant to section 616 (3) of the *Act*.

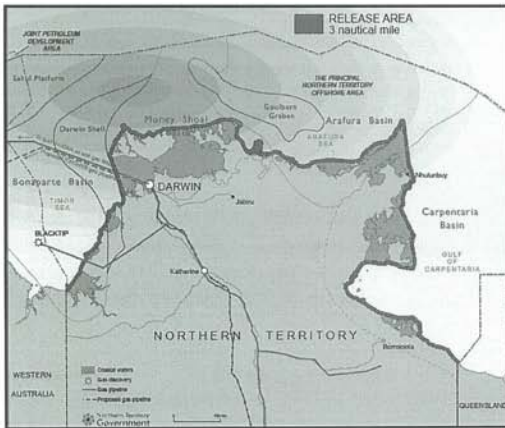

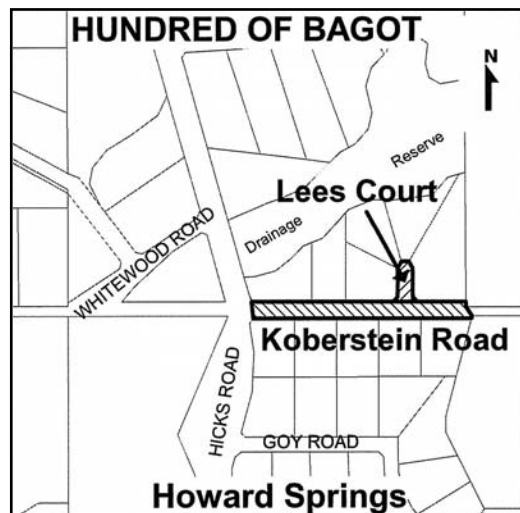
