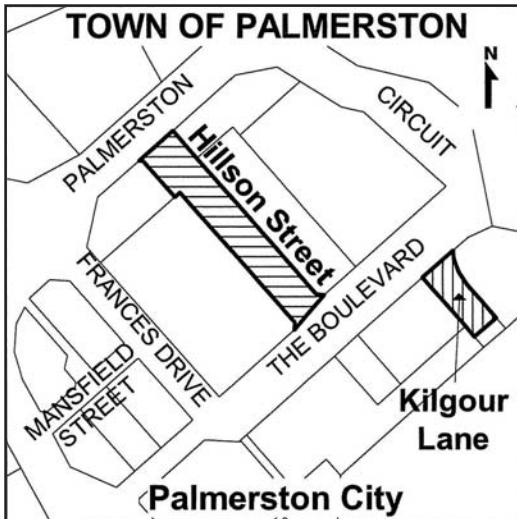
**NAMING OF PLACE**

COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA

PROHIBITION OF ENTRY INTO A SAFETY ZONE

I, JEREMY PAUL WHITFIELD, Director of Energy,  
Northern Territory Department Of Regional Development,

Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources, of the said Territory by instrument of delegation 25 August 2008, and pursuant to section 616 of the above *Act*, hereby prohibit all vessels other than those operating on behalf of the ENI Blacktip Gas Project and vessels operated by authorised persons who are exercising powers under Part 6.6 Division 1 section 614 and 615 of the above *Act* and Australian Customs Vessels defined as Commonwealth Ships under the *Australian Customs Act 1901* from entering or remaining in the area of the safety zone without the consent in writing of the Designated Authority of the Joint Authority for the Offshore Area of the External Territory Of Ashmore and Cartier Islands. This safety zone extends to a distance of five hundred meters, measured from:

The Safety Zone remains in force until further notice.

Where an unauthorised vessel enters or remains in the safety zone specified in contravention of this instrument, the owner and the person in command or in charge of the vessel are each guilty of an offence against section 616 of the *Act* and are punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$100,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years, or both, pursuant to section 616 (3) of the *Act*.

### Livestock Act

#### DECLARED AREA MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS BEES AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT AND PRODUCTS

I, BRIAN LESLIE RADUNZ, Chief Inspector, under section 59(1) of the *Livestock Act* and with reference to section 8 of the *Interpretation Act*, in relation to the declaration of a protected area for the notifiable diseases American foulbrood (*Paenibacillus larvae*), European foulbrood (*Melissococcus pluton*) and Small hive beetle (*Aethina tumida*), dated 18 March 2009 and published in *Gazette* No. G12 of 25 March 2009, restrict the movement of bees, and equipment and products associated with bees, as specified in the Schedule.

#### SCHEDULE

### 1 Definition

In this Schedule:

**interstate inspector**, in relation to a State or another Territory from which bees, equipment used in connection with bees, beeswax, bee candy or bee-collected pollen are being brought into the Territory, means a person appointed under an Act of that State or Territory who may exercise powers or perform functions relating to bees and the control of American foulbrood, European foulbrood or small hive beetle.

**2 Movement permit required**

A person must apply to an inspector under section 59(2) of the *Livestock Act* for a declared area movement permit before bringing bees, equipment or products mentioned in this Schedule into the Territory from a State or another Territory.

**3 Bees**

Only the following bees may be brought into the Territory:

- (a) from any State or another Territory – hand picked queen bees or escorts;
- (b) from Western Australia – package bees in relation to which:
  - (i) each location from which the bees derive, and any establishment from which the bees are being imported, is within the SHB free area as defined in the Agriculture and Related Resources Protection (Small Hive Beetle) Regulations 2009 (WA) (the SHB free area); and
  - (ii) within 7 days before the bees begin the journey to the Territory – the locations from which they derive and from which they are being imported have been inspected for small hive beetle by an interstate inspector, with negative results; and
  - (iii) within 21 days before the bees begin the journey to the Territory – an interstate inspector has verified that the locations

from which they derive and from which they are being imported have been tested for American foulbrood and European foulbrood, with negative results; and

- (iv) the container in which the packages of bees are kept during importation has remained closed at all times during movement through areas of Western Australia that are not within the SHB free area.

**4 Equipment**

Equipment that has been used in connection with bees may be brought into the Territory from a State or another Territory only if, before entry:

- (a) all metal parts of the equipment are irradiated with 15 kilo Gray or steam cleaned to the satisfaction of an interstate inspector; and
- (b) all non-metal parts of the equipment are irradiated with 15 kilo Gray or dipped in hot wax or a caustic solution, in either case to the satisfaction of an interstate inspector.

**5 Beeswax**

Before beeswax is brought into the Territory from a State or another Territory, the beeswax must be heated to melting point.

**6 Bee candy and bee-collected pollen**

Before bee candy or bee-collected pollen is brought into the Territory from a State or another Territory, the candy or pollen must be irradiated with 15 kilo Gray.
