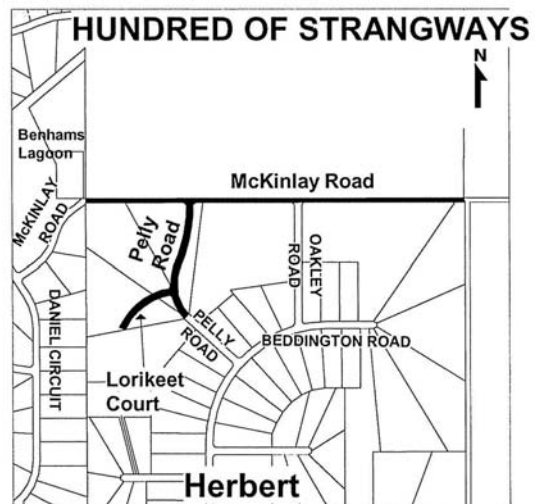
NAMING OF PLACE

- PELLY ROAD** Named after the residence of the original owner of the land in Ormskirk, Lancashire, UK and later owner of the land Percy Pelly.
- McKINLAY ROAD** Named after the explorer John McKinlay. In 1866, John McKinlay, explored from Escape Cliffs to the East Alligator River mouth.
- LORIKEET COURT** Named after the brightly coloured parrot which occurs in large numbers around Darwin, where it feeds on the various flowering gums.
