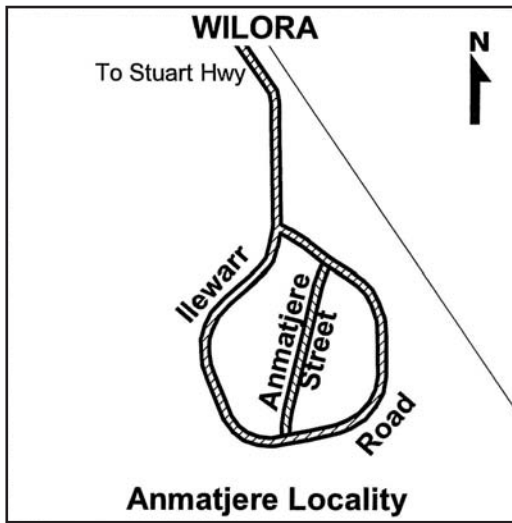
NAMING OF PLACE
