## Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act

### REDECLARATION OF PARKS AND RESERVES

I, KARL RIO HAMPTON, Minister for Parks and Wildlife, under section 24(2) of the *Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act*:

- (a) revoke each declaration under section 12 of the *Act* specified in Schedule 1; and
- (b) declare each area of land specified in Schedule 2, Part 1, to be a reserve; and
- (c) declare each area of land specified in Schedule 2, Part 2, to be a park; and
- (d) declare that a right, title or interest held by the Territory in respect of the land, or a part of the land (including any subsoil), within each park or reserve declared by paragraphs (b) and (c) does not, on the declaration of the park or reserve, vest in the Conservation Land Corporation.

**Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act**
