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Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act

APPROVAL TO POSSESS AND SUPPLY SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES

I, BARBARA ANN PATERSON, the Chief Health Officer, for the purposes of section 29(4A) of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and with reference to section 42 of the *Interpretation Act*, approve each registered nurse within the meaning of the *Health Practitioners Act* who is employed to perform duties at or from a health centre that is specified in Appendix A to possess and supply a substance listed in Schedule 2, 3, or 4 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* in the course of his or her duties, subject to the following conditions:
