Radiation Protection Act

EXEMPTION FROM APPLICATION OF ACT

I, BARBARA ANN PATERSON, the Chief Health Officer, pursuant to section 10 of the *Radiation Protection Act*, exempt Americium 241 sealed sources of radiation activity of up to and including 40kBq, being used in domestic smoke alarms meeting the requirements of AS3786:1993 as amended from time to time, subject to the conditions specified in the Schedule, from the *Act*.

For disposal purposes, a maximum of ten domestic smoke alarms may be disposed of in a domestic or commercial rubbish receptacle at any one time, provided that the trefoil radiation hazard symbol on the domestic smoke alarm has been painted over or adequately covered so it is no longer visible.

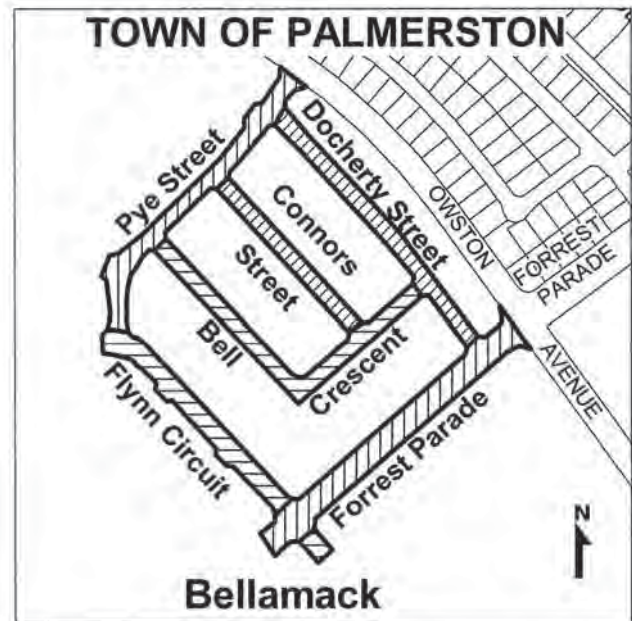
