APPROVAL OF LASER ATLANTA SPEEDLASER® AS TRAFFIC INFRINGEMENT DETECTION DEVICE

I, PAUL CAMERON WHITE, the Commissioner of Police, in pursuance of section 44(1) of the *Traffic Act* and with reference to section 44AA of the *Traffic Act*, approve the SpeedLaser® as a device, manufactured by Laser Atlanta, Norcross, Georgia USA as a traffic infringement detection device, subject to the following conditions:

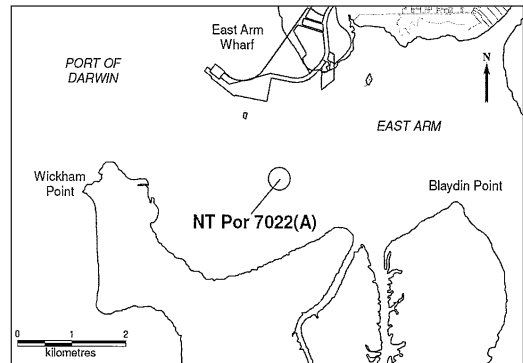
