Livestock ActDECLARED AREA MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS
CATTLE TICKS (RHIPICEPHALUS MICROPLUS)

I, BRIAN LESLIE RADUNZ, Chief Inspector:

(a) under section 59(1) of the *Livestock Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument entitled "Declared area movement restrictions

cattle ticks (*Rhipicephalus microplus*)" dated 18 June 2009 and published in *Gazette* No. G25 of 24 June 2009; and

(b) under section 59(1) of the *Livestock Act*, in relation to the declared areas specified in the declaration for the notifiable disease cattle ticks (*Rhipicephalus microplus*), dated 29 April 2009 and published in *Gazette* No. G23 of 10 June 2009, as amended by the instrument entitled "Amendment of declaration declared areas cattle ticks (*Rhipicephalus microplus*)", dated 19 November 2009 and published in *Gazette* No. G48 of 2 December 2009, restrict the movement of restricted livestock as specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1 Definitions

In this Schedule:

certified solution means a solution of which a sample has been chemically analysed by a laboratory approved by the Chief Inspector and certified by the laboratory to be a sample of a registered acaricide of a registered strength.

Clean inspection, of restricted livestock, means:

- (a) an inspection of the livestock by an inspector; and
- (b) a declaration by the inspector that the livestock are free of visible ticks or free of ticks containing bodily fluids.

Control Zone means the area declared as such under the Cattle Ticks Declaration.

Free property means a property where cattle ticks are not known to occur.

Free Zone means the area declared as such under the Cattle Ticks Declaration.

Infected property means a property on which cattle ticks are known or suspected to occur.

Infected Zone means the area declared as such under the Cattle Ticks Declaration.

Registered means registered by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority established by the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Administration) Act 1992* (Cth).

Restricted livestock means cattle, buffalo, horses, camels, llamas, alpaca, goats, sheep and deer.

Supervised treatment, of restricted livestock, means the livestock are fully immersed, under the supervision and with the approval of an inspector, in a certified solution that was certified within 60 days before the immersion or, for export yards, within 30 days before the immersion.

Supervised treatment (free property), of restricted livestock, means the livestock are:

- (a) fully immersed, under the supervision and with the approval of an inspector, in a certified solution that was certified within 60 days before the immersion; or
- (b) treated, under the supervision and with the approval of an inspector, with a registered macrocyclic lactone according to the instructions of the manufacturer.

2 Restrictions before movement starts

- (1) If restricted livestock are to be moved from a declared area, or a property in a declared area, specified in the Table, column 1, into or through a declared area as specified opposite in column 2, the owner of the livestock must ensure the procedure specified opposite in column 3 is completed within the following period:
- (a) for restricted livestock except horses 24 hours before the movement starts;
 - (b) for horses:
 - (i) 24 hours before the movement starts; or
 - (ii) a longer period of no more than 48 hours before the movement starts, as approved by an inspector.
- (2) Before restricted livestock are moved from a declared area, or a property in a declared area, specified in the Table, column 1, to or through a declared area as specified opposite in column 2, the owner of the livestock must apply to an inspector for a declared area movement permit.
