DECLARATION OF RESTRICTED AREA  
AILERON STATION (NT PORTION 703)

The Northern Territory Licensing Commission, by virtue of its power under Section 74 of the *Liquor Act* has determined that the following area of land shall be a restricted area within the meaning of Part VIII of the *Act*.

All that parcel of land within the Aileron Station Pastoral Lease (NT Portion 703), in the Northern Territory of Australia, Commencing at the intersection of Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 02 minutes 11 seconds with Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 33 minutes 57 seconds; thence east by the said Parallel to intersect Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 43 minutes 42 seconds; thence south by said Meridian to intersect the Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 34 minutes 14 seconds; thence east by the said Parallel to intersect Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 50 minutes 11 seconds; thence south by the said Meridian to intersect the Parallel of South Latitude 23 degrees 01 minutes 07 seconds; thence west by the said Parallel to intersect Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 02 minutes 11 seconds; thence north by the said Meridian to the point of commencement, including all roads within the above described area but excluding those sections of the Stuart Highway which pass through Portion 703 and also excluding from the area -

The Aileron Homestead Complex, commencing at the intersection of Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 20 minutes 37.8 seconds with Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 38 minutes 40.1 seconds: thence 190 degrees 19 minutes 159.5 metres; 278 degrees 38 minutes 20 seconds 225.3 metres; thence 11 degrees 45 minutes 10 seconds 182.25 metres to the point of commencement.

All coordinates quoted being on the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994.

This determination shall have effect from Monday 1 February 2010.

This determination means that from Monday 1 February 2010 liquor may not be taken into or consumed within the area described above, without a permit. Section 75 of the *Act* states that subject to this Part, a person shall not;

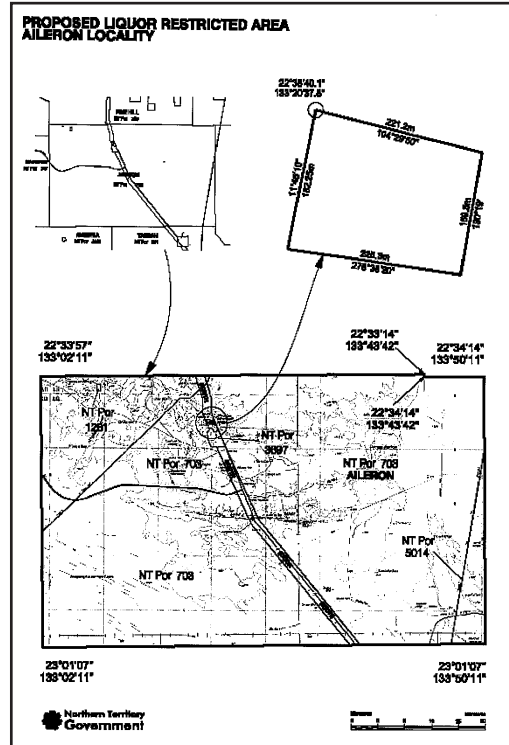
- (a) bring liquor into;
- (b) have liquor in his possession or under his control within, or
- (c) consume, sell or otherwise dispose of liquor within, a restricted area.

Infringements of this declaration are punishable by a fine of \$1000 or six months gaol for the first offence, and up to \$2000 or twelve months gaol for the second or subsequent offence.

Vehicles, aircraft or vessels illegally carrying liquor into the area may be seized and forfeited.

DECLARATION OF RESTRICTED AREA  
PINE HILL STATION (NT PORTION 725)

The Northern Territory Licensing Commission, by virtue of its power under Section 74 of the *Liquor Act* has determined that the following area of land shall be a restricted area within the meaning of Part VIII of the *Act*.

All that parcel of land within the Pine Hill Station Pastoral Lease (NT Portion 725) in the Northern Territory of Australia, Commencing at the intersection of Meridian of East Longitude 132 degrees 43 minutes 30 seconds with Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 13 minutes 12 seconds; thence east by the said Parallel to intersect Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 12 minutes 14 seconds; thence south by said Meridian to intersect the Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 16 minutes 57 seconds; thence east by the said Parallel to intersect Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 43 minutes 42 seconds; thence south by the

said Meridian to intersect the Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 33 minutes 57 seconds; thence west by the said Parallel to intersect Meridian of Longitude 133 degrees 02 minutes 11 seconds; thence north by the said Meridian to intersect Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 27 minutes 47 seconds; thence in a general north westerly direction along the Reynolds Range to the point of commencement, including all roads within the above described area but excluding those sections of the Stuart Highway which pass through Portion 725 and also excluding from the area-

The Pine Hill Homestead Complex, commencing at the intersection of Meridian of East Longitude 133 degrees 03 minutes 2.8 seconds with Parallel of South Latitude 22 degrees 22 minutes 45.2 seconds: thence 94 degrees 46 minutes 30 seconds 591.42 metres; 184 degrees 54 minutes 1071.4 metres; 312 degrees 35 minutes 1095.69 metres; thence 39 degrees 28 minutes 486.14 metres to the point of commencement.

All coordinates quoted being on the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994.

This determination shall have effect from Monday 1 February 2010.

This determination means that from Monday 1 February 2010 liquor may not be taken into or consumed within the area described above, without a permit. Section 75 of the Act states that subject to this Part, a person shall not;

- (a) bring liquor into;
- (b) have liquor in his possession or under his control within, or
- (c) consume, sell or otherwise dispose of liquor within, a restricted area.

Infringements of this declaration are punishable by a fine of \$1000 or six months gaol for the first offence, and up to \$2000 or twelve months gaol for the second or subsequent offence.

Vehicles, aircraft or vessels illegally carrying liquor into the area may be seized and forfeited.
