Control of Roads Act**TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTIONS**

I, PETER TOLL, Project Director Civil Darwin, as delegate of the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure, being satisfied saturated pavement may make the road or part of the road specified in column 1 of the Schedule subject to deterioration by the passage of vehicles, pursuant to section 11(1)(b) of the *Control of Roads Act*, give notice of the following decisions:

- (a) pursuant to section 11(1)(b) of the *Act*, use of the road or part of the road is restricted to vehicles
- (i) the mass of each of which does not exceed the mass specified in column 2 of the Schedule; or
 - (ii) the mass of each of which does not exceed the percentage of the mass limit for the type of axle or axle group (other than a steer axle) specified in column 3 of the Schedule and the total number of axles of which does not exceed the number specified in that column;
- (b) pursuant to section 11(1)(b) of the *Act*, the restrictions on the use or manner of use specified in column 4 of the Schedule are imposed,

from 3.25pm, Thursday, 2 June 2011.

For this notice, "GCM" or an expression relating the specifications for a vehicle has the same meaning as it has under the Motor Vehicle (Standards) Regulations; except that "GVM" has the same meaning as it has under the Australian Road Rules.

Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act

APPROVAL TO POSSESS AND SUPPLY SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES

I, BARBARA ANN PATERSON, the Chief Health Officer, for the purposes of section 29(4C) of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and with reference to section 42 of the *Interpretation Act*, approve a person who is registered under the *Health Practitioners Act* in the category of Aboriginal Health Worker who is employed to perform duties:

- (a) at or from a health centre that is specified in Appendix A;
- (b) at or from a health service premises specified in Appendix B; to possess and supply a substance listed in Schedule 2, 3, or 4 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* in the course of his or her duties, subject to the following conditions:
- (c) a substance specified in Appendix C is to be supplied only in accordance with the permitted manner of administration for the substance indicated in Column 2 of the Appendix; and
- (d) a substance that is listed in Schedule 2, 3, or 4 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and is not specified in Appendix C is only to be supplied under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, optometrist or a dentist.
