

Apprenticeships

Does Northern Territory Treasury employ apprentices?

Yes! Treasury employs apprentices through the New Apprentice Program (NAP) and Indigenous apprentices through the Structured Training and Employment Program (STEP). Treasury employs apprentices for a 12 month period to complete a Certificate III in Business which combines on the job training and formal training.

Who is eligible to apply for an apprenticeship?

Anyone who has successfully completed a minimum of Year 10 is eligible to apply. However if you are a current public sector employee or you have already gained a Certificate III qualification in the last seven years, you are ineligible.

What is the commencing salary for an apprentice at Treasury?

NAP and STEP apprentices are employed as a temporary employee. The commencing salary is adjusted according to the apprentice age and the level of education that they have completed.

What happens after I complete the 12 month apprenticeship?

After the completion of the 12 month program, apprentices can:

- apply for the National Indigenous Cadetship Program; or
- seek further employment in the Northern Territory Public Sector.

There is no guarantee of permanent appointment at the end of the program.
