Indigenous Cadetship Support (ICS)

Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander?

If you are enrolled to study at university, you can apply for the Indigenous Cadetship Support (ICS) program.

How does ICS work?

Northern Territory Public Sector (NTPS) agencies identify the areas in which they require Indigenous cadets. Applicants are then matched to these agencies according to their area of study.

If applicants are successfully matched to an agency, they will become cadets and be paid:

- a study allowance of \$12 000 (\$600 gross per fortnight) each year while studying;
- paid work placements for 12 weeks during the semester break/s (paid at the Administration Officer 2 level, currently \$42 686 per annum);
- a book and equipment allowance (\$1000 each year); and
- Higher Education Loan Program (HELP) fees will be paid for all units passed.

Eligibility for a cadetship

Applicants must:

- identify as an Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander; and
- be enrolled for full-time study at a Registered Training Organisation for a diploma, advanced diploma or at a university located in Australia for their first undergraduate degree course.
