This form is to be used by former employees of the Northern Territory public sector (NTPS) who ceased employment after 1 October 1986 but who did not lodge a claim for a superannuation benefit or failed to receive a claimed benefit.

You may be eligible to claim a benefit from the Northern Territory Government and Public Authorities' Superannuation Scheme and/or the Northern Territory Supplementary Superannuation Scheme.
