UTILITIES COMMISSION REGULATIONS

Regulations under the *Utilities Commission Act*

1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Utilities Commission Regulations.
(See back note 1)

2. Authorisation to make code

(1) The Utilities Commission is authorised to make a code relating to ring fencing in a regulated industry.

(2) In subregulation (1) –

"ring fencing" means the separate operation of related or associated businesses of a licensed entity in a regulated industry.

3. Authorisation to make rules and determinations

(1) The Utilities Commission is authorised to make rules relating to the provision of ancillary services in the electricity supply industry.

(2) The Utilities Commission is authorised to make determinations relating to the prices for providing ancillary services in the electricity supply industry.

(3) In this regulation –

"ancillary services" include –

- (a) reserve capacity;
- (b) frequency support;
- (c) load following services; and

- (d) services necessary for the efficient and reliable operation of a power system.
