



## Demerit Points - Withdrawal From Good Driving Behaviour (GDB)

**NOTE: Withdrawal from a GDB undertaking does not stop the consequences of a demerit points offence committed before the GDB period ceases.**

- If you decide to withdraw, please sign and date the Withdrawal section.
- Ensure that you have completed the Personal Details section.
- Present this Form **in person** at an MVR or remote Police Station. If you believe that it would be unduly onerous for you to attend in person, please call 1300 364 924 for alternative means to establish your identity.

### Withdrawal

**Essential information about withdrawal from GDB follows. It is important that you read and fully understand this information before deciding whether to withdraw from GDB.**

In relation to my Notice of Suspension, I seek to withdraw from my undertaking to be of good driving behaviour for 12 months, acknowledging that:

1. **THE SUSPENSION PERIOD SPECIFIED IN MY NOTICE OF SUSPENSION WILL BEGIN** the day after this withdrawal is accepted by an MVR outlet (e.g. if this withdrawal is lodged today at an MVR outlet, the Suspension Period will begin at midnight tonight; if it is lodged today at a remote Police Station after normal business hours, the Suspension Period will begin at the end of the next MVR working day at midnight);
2. My GDB period ceases when the Suspension Period begins;
3. I am not entitled to undertake to be of good driving behaviour again in relation to the Suspension Period;
4. If I have incurred 2 or more demerit points before my GDB period ceases, in breach of my GDB undertaking, I will be issued a Further Notice of Suspension specifying a Suspension Period that is double the original Suspension Period (e.g. if the original period is 3 months, and 1 month has been served, a further 5 months must be served);
5. **I MUST NOT DRIVE** during any period for which my driver licence is suspended; doing so may result in me being charged with an offence;
6. If my driver licence expires during my Suspension Period, the Suspension Period continues to run;
7. The Suspension Period will cease to run (or will not begin to run) during a period of licence suspension or disqualification under another law (other than for fine default), and will resume (or commence as the case may be) immediately after the other period ends;
8. If my licence is or has been suspended due to fine default and that suspension overlaps the Suspension Period, the periods will run concurrently; and
9. Suspension of my driver licence may disqualify me from driving elsewhere in Australia (and other countries) for the Suspension Period.
