## **Notes for Guidance**

If you are completing this Statutory Declaration on behalf of a Business/Company/Association or other group, you must provide evidence that you have the authority to act on behalf of that Business/Company Association or Group (section 2 of this form).

Examples of documents that may be submitted (section 5 of this form):

- Invoices or receipts for parts.
- Invoices or receipts for labour, maintenance, storage or transport of vehicle.
- Any other documents that provide a direct link to any services provided in connection with the vehicle.
- Notice under Part 2 of the *Uncollected Goods Act*.
- Court Order (if applicable).
- Certificate from Commissioner of Police regarding stolen vehicle status issued under section 19 of the *Uncollected Goods Act* (if applicable).

## **Warning**

- Persons who by false statement or misrepresentation obtain or attempt to obtain registration or renewal of registration or transfer of a motor vehicle, are liable to a penalty not exceeding \$2000 or imprisonment for 6 months under the *Motor Vehicles Act*.
- Under Section 59 of the *Taxation (Administration) Act*, persons who falsely declare sale price and/or the market value of a vehicle are liable to a penalty of \$5000.

## **Privacy Statement**

The Registrar of Motor Vehicles is required to collect information for Registrations, Licenses and Permits under section 92 of the NT *Motor Vehicles Act*.
