

R11 – Powered Wheel Chairs

Effective Date: 18 September 1997

From 1 July 1996, the Traffic Act was amended to register and insure motorised wheel chairs which do exceed the speed capability of ten [10] kilometres per hour.

NOTE: All other wheel chairs are not registered and persons riding in the wheel chair are deemed to be pedestrians.

Inspection Requirements

A roadworthy inspection is required on the first registration only.

A Transport Inspector may visit the person concerned for the inspection. An appointment may be made by contacting the Motor Vehicle Registry, Vehicle Standards Section, during normal business hours.

Number Plates and Labels

Standard car plates and labels will be issued. An exemption may be granted to display one [1] number plate only if requested.

Fees

A flat registration and MACA insurance fee will apply. For further information on fees, please contact your nearest MVR office.
