Stuart Highway – Bootu Underpass Repair Works Road restrictions in place north of Tennant Creek

The Department of Planning and Infrastructure has placed road restrictions on the Stuart Highway at Bootu Creek Underpass, north of Tennant Creek.

Following heavy rain in the area, repair work needs to be undertaken on the bridge.

Vehicles exceeding 4.5 tonne will not be permitted to use the road between 8.00am and 5.00pm on Thursday 9 and Friday 10 February. This is to allow repair work to proceed, without any further damage being caused.

Department of Planning and Infrastructure's Regional Manager, John Bertram said, "Transport inspectors will today advise industry in the region so that heavy vehicles do not attempt to use the road during these times."

All other vehicles can continue to use the Highway but may experience short delays.

Motorists are urged to drive cautiously and adhere to all signage in place.
