FREE BUSES TO HIDDEN VALLEY FOR V8 SUPERCARS

Why drive when you can catch a free bus to the V8 Supercars at Hidden Valley Raceway, said Transport Minister, Dr Chris Burns.

“The Territory Government is providing the free bus services to and from Hidden Valley for the three day event which commences on Friday.

“We encourage all race-goers to leave their cars at home and take advantage of the free bus service to avoid the frustration of parking and traffic queues,” said Dr Burns.

“On Friday 30 June, a decorated V8 bus will provide a direct service from the Darwin Bus Interchange to Hidden Valley every half hour from 9am til 5pm.

“On the weekend, free buses will depart from Casuarina, Darwin, Nightcliff, Palmerston and the rural area interchanges on a regular basis,” said Dr Burns.

“Buses returning to Darwin City on Friday will depart the track every half hour while on the weekend they will depart as per the Saturday/Sunday bus schedule.

“Furthermore, Major Events will run a shuttle bus service at Hidden Valley raceway to ensure pedestrians can travel from one end of the track to the other without having to battle the crowds.

“So have a great time at the V8 Supercars – leave your car at home and avoid the hassle of traffic and parking by catching a bus to this world class event!”
