## **Free Buses to Powderfinger Silverchair Concert**

It's the must see event touring Australia and now it's Darwin's turn.

'Across The Great Divide' – the concert with two of Australia's greatest rock bands, Powderfinger and Silverchair, is playing this Friday night at Darwin Showgrounds.

Northern Territory Transport Minister, Delia Lawrie today announced there will be free buses to and from the concert.

"Powderfinger and Silverchair have been busing it round the country since August, so why not do the same and catch a bus to their concert."

"Catching a free bus means you don't have to worry about parking, you can enjoy a few drinks and know there's a designated driver."

Buses marked 'special' will depart from and return to the Casuarina, Darwin and Palmerston bus interchanges with an additional service to Noonamah.
