Interruptions to Bus Services

Friday 21 December 2007

The Transport Workers union has advised that industrial action is intended to be taken this Friday December 21 2007.

There will be interruptions to the public transport bus services in the Darwin and Palmerston areas.

All routes of travel will experience interruptions at various times throughout the day. It is expected that about half the fleet of buses will be operating on Friday.

The greatest impact on bus routes will be:

- Route 5 Casuarina to Darwin and Darwin to Casuarina via Winnellie
- Route 6 Darwin to Darwin loop via Fannie Bay
- Route 9 Casuarina to Palmerston
- Express Services not running include – morning routes for 22 (Leanyer to Darwin); and 25 (Karama to Darwin); and both morning and afternoon routes for 28 (Palmerston to Darwin).

Flyers indicating the likely bus services will be distributed at the Casuarina, Palmerston and Darwin interchanges, and at the bus stop near Woolworths on Cavenagh Street. They will be distributed Thursday afternoon and Friday from 6am.

The travelling public is encouraged to consider alternative methods of transport to minimise any inconvenience.

Normal services will resume on Saturday morning, 22 December 2007.
