Bus fares guide

A guide to bus fares on scheduled public bus services in the Northern Territory.

Effective November 2006



The bus fare structure is simple and easy to understand. Bus tickets can be purchased either on board the bus, at any bus interchange in Darwin or at the Alice Springs Airport Shuttle Shop as detailed in this brochure.

Bus fares

- **adult (cost: \$2.00)**
An adult fare entitles the passenger to unlimited bus travel for three (3) hours on any scheduled public bus service in Darwin and Alice Springs. The bus ticket is valid for three(3) hours from the time of validation.
- **concession (cost: \$0.50)**
A concession (student/child/pensioner/senior/concession card holder) fare entitles the passenger to unlimited bus travel for three (3) hours on any scheduled public bus service in Darwin and Alice Springs. The bus ticket is valid for three (3) hours from the time of validation.
- **show&go daily (cost: \$5.00)**
A **show&go daily** bus ticket entitles the passenger to unlimited bus travel on any scheduled public bus service in Darwin and Alice Springs. The bus ticket is valid from the first scheduled bus service to the last scheduled bus service on the day of validation.
- **show&go weekly* (cost: \$15.00)**
A **show&go weekly** bus ticket entitles the passenger to unlimited bus travel on any scheduled public bus service in Darwin and Alice Springs. The bus ticket is valid from the first scheduled bus service on Monday through to the last scheduled bus service on Sunday during the week of validation. The bus ticket provides value for money with a 25% discount applied in comparison to equal adult fares.
- **adult 10 book* (cost: \$18.00)**
A book of ten (10) adult tickets provides passengers who travel less frequently the ability to travel at their convenience, whilst receiving a 10% discount.

* **show&go weekly** and **adult 10 book** tickets are **not** available for purchase on board the bus and can only be pre-purchased at bus interchanges in Darwin, Casuarina and Palmerston or at the Alice Springs Airport Shuttle Shop.

Concessions and free travel

Concession fares apply to any person presenting a valid student identification card, pensioner/carer/concession/seniors card or health care card.

- **school student/child (concession fare)**
Available to students aged 5 to 15 years attending school or secondary college; or students in possession of a current term or weekly school bus pass.
- **pensioner and senior (concession fare)**
Available to passengers presenting a valid Pensioner Concession Card, a Pensioner and Carer Concession Card, a Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card or a Government Seniors Card.
- **Australian educational institution (concession fare)**
Available to students presenting a valid **full time** student identification card issued by an Australian educational institution. Students of international universities are **not** eligible for any discounted fares.
- **health care (concession fare)**
Available to persons presenting a valid health care card. All persons nominated on the health care card are entitled to a concession fare.
- **vision impaired**
A person presenting a vision impaired travel pass is entitled to **free travel**.
- **Veterans' Affairs "gold" card**
A person presenting a Veterans' Affairs "gold" card is entitled to **free travel**.
- **adult complimentary passes**
A person presenting a complimentary bus pass issued by Public Transport is entitled to travel on any scheduled public bus service in Darwin and Alice Springs without paying any additional money. Only the holder of the complimentary bus pass is eligible to travel.
