

School Bus Passes

(Effective February 2006)

Free bus passes are issued by schools to eligible students who require bus transport to and from school. The eligibility criteria are based on the distance the student lives from the school they are attending. Contact your school for more information regarding eligibility.

Bus passes for school students are also available for purchase at \$45 per school term or \$4.50 per week. You can purchase these bus passes from the bus interchanges or some schools.

Both these passes can be used for travel on a dedicated school bus or any other bus operating on the urban network, Monday to Friday, on school days, including pupil free days. There is no daily time restriction for when the pass can be used. This means the student can travel on a bus whenever the bus service is operating that day.

The passes are not valid for travel on public holidays or during school holidays. During these periods the bus pass can be used as a form of student identification to obtain a child fare.

The bus pass should be used for travel to and from school and for travel to school related activities including (but not limited to) tutoring, study periods, library, sporting activities etc.
