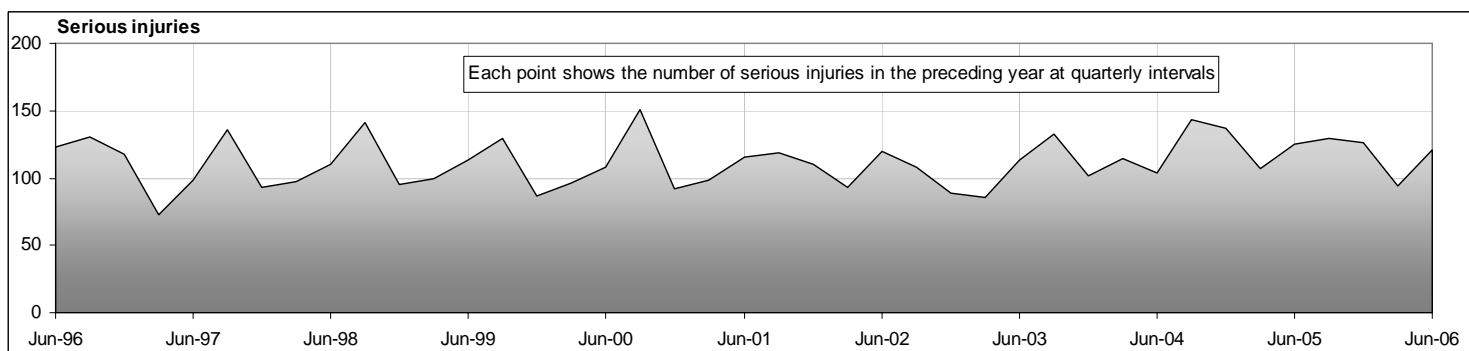
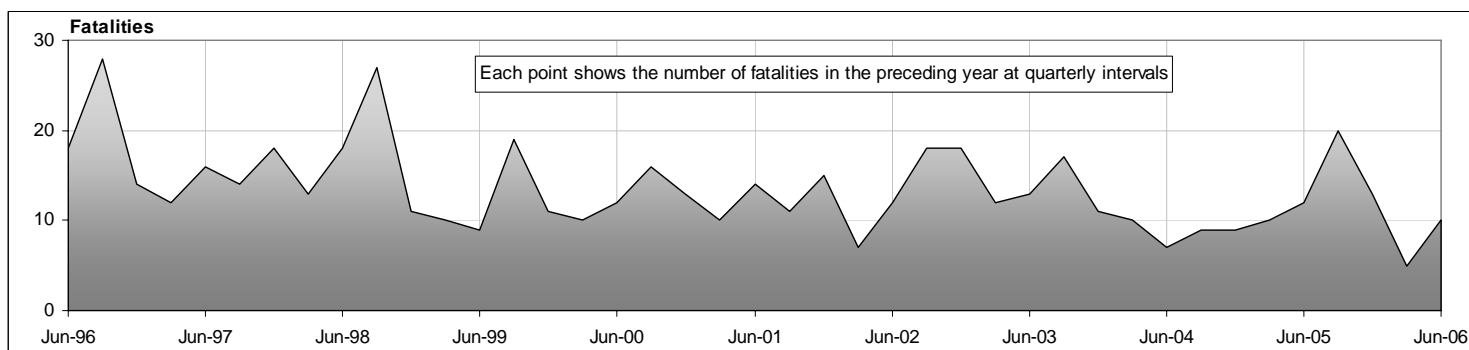


### Key figures

Between 1 January and 30 June 2006 there have been 15 fatalities and 215 serious injuries on Northern Territory roads. There have been 48 fatalities in the 12-months to date which represents a 20% increase on the same period in the preceding year.

The 12-months to date statistics indicate that 24 fatalities were alcohol related (50%); in 19 fatalities a seatbelt was not worn when one was available (40%); 12 fatalities were pedestrians (25%). 24 people killed were Indigenous (50%) and 24 were non-Indigenous (50%); 34 were male (71%) and 14 were female (29%).

Causal and compounding factors do not total to the number of fatalities or serious injuries recorded. There may be more than one causal and/or compounding factor identified for each fatality or serious injury, or Police may not have identified a causal or compounding factor.

Speed related statistics more accurately refer to speeding rather than speed as a causal factor, where a driver was breaking the speed limit or travelling at a dangerous speed. Where there is no speed limit, cause is likely to be attributed to a non-speed related cause such as 'driver inattention', notwithstanding that speed is a factor in any crash.
